

**Minutes of the 126<sup>th</sup> EXIM Committee meeting for Export and Import of Seeds and Planting Materials held under the Chairmanship of Shri S.L. Bhat, Additional Secretary, Government of India, DoAC at 11.30 A.M. on 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2008.**

The 126<sup>th</sup> meeting of the EXIM Committee for Export and Import of Seeds and Planting Materials was held at 11.30 a.m. on 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2008 under the Chairmanship of Shri S.L. Bhat, Additional Secretary, DoAC and the meeting was attended by officers from Horticulture Division, PP Division of DAC, ICAR and other organizations. The list of participants is annexed as Annexure-I.

**Item No. 1a: Action Taken Report of 125<sup>th</sup> EXIM Committee Meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2008.**

M/s. Deve Bhumi Cold Chain Pvt. Ltd., Delhi applied for import of 20,000Nos. of Strawberry plants, which has been considered by the 125<sup>th</sup> EXIM Committee and the same was deferred for want of clarification about the PEQ Facilities available for establishing the material.

Now, the company in question submitted the required information therefore, the Committee recommended the import of total 20,000 Nos. Strawberry plants C.V. NF 137 and Seneca 10,000 Nos. each from Italy by M/s. Dev Bhumi Cold Chain Pvt. Ltd., Plot No.17 & 18, New Subzi Mandi, Azadpur, Delhi-110033 subject to submission of legible lucid PEQ Certificate and further subject to Plant Quarantine (Regulation of Import into India) Order, 2003 and amendments made therein.

**Item No. 1b:**

The Committee deferred the following eight proposals for import of berseem seed during the 125<sup>th</sup> EXIM Committee Meeting for want of clarification from the company concerned. It has been stated that the import of Berseem seed increasing every year, however, the production of Berseem in the country has not been increased as expected by the Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairy and Fisheries. Taking into consideration, the committee decided to meet the importers, who import the berseem seed regularly, for discussion and to find out the reasons for the huge import and its use other than the fodder purpose.

The representatives of the berseem seed producers/dealers discussed the issue with regard to import of berseem seed with the Committee members and informed that they are importing the seed in question for sowing and planting purpose only and this berseem seed is used exclusively for fodder purpose and not for other purposes. They have also assured to the Committee that they will provide the information in connection with supply of import of berseem seed to the different agencies for reference as well as to take policy decision in this regard. After the indepth discussion, Committee recommended to import berseem seed C.V. Mescavi subject to **weed risk analysis report** to be conducted by NBPGR. The details are as follows:
