

Minutes of the 135th EXIM Committee meeting for Export and Import of Seeds and Planting Materials held on 25th March, 2009 at 3.00 p.m. under the Chairmanship of Shri G.C.Pati, Additional Secretary, Government of India.

The 135th EXIM Committee meeting for Export and Import of Seeds and Planting Materials was held on 25th March, 2009 at 3.00 p.m. under the Chairmanship of Shri G.C.Pati, Additional Secretary, Government of India and the meeting was attended by officers from Seeds Divisions, Horticulture Division, PP Division of DAC, ICAR and other organizations. The list of participants is at Annexure-I.

Item No.1: Action Taken Report of 134th EXIM Committee meeting held on 3rd March, 2009.

Minutes of the 134th EXIM Committee meeting has not yet been finalized. Action taken report for this meeting would be placed in the 136th meeting of the Committee.

Follow up action on Wheat seed & Raspberry plants - Import proposals:

Item No.1(A): Proposal for import of total 866 kgs Wheat seed c.v Kinde#1, Chonte#1, Kishadee#1, Picaflor#1, Quaiu#1, Pauraque#1 & Francolin#1 @ 100 kgs each and Quaiu#2 – 166 kgs from Mexico by M/s. Mahyco Seeds Limited, 4E/15, Ashoka Centre, IIIrd Floor, Jhandewalan Extension, New Delhi-110055.

The Committee felt that import of Wheat may bring in exotic pest and diseases. Besides, para 4.2 of the New Policy on Seed Development, 1988 also indicates that no immediate import of Wheat and Paddy are considered necessary. Therefore, the proposal under reference is recommended for rejection.

Item No.1(B): Proposal for import of 1,00,000 Nos. Raspberry plants c.v. Paramount from California by M/s. Parth Farms, P.O. Box No.31, Panchgani, District Satara, Maharashtra-412 805.

The Committee noted that the proposal in question has been discussed by the 133rd Committee meeting which directed the firm to submit the PEQ Certificate as per the revised guidelines of the Plant Quarantine (Regulation of import into India) Order, 2003, and amendment made therein. Accordingly, the company under reference has submitted the required PEQ Certificate. Therefore, the Committee recommended the import of 1,00,000 Nos. Raspberry plants c.v. Paramount from California by M/s. Parth Farms, P.O. Box No.31, Panchgani, District Satara, Maharashtra-412 805, subject to the Plant Quarantine (Regulation of import into India) Order, 2003, and amendment made therein.

EXPORT OF ONION SEEDS:

- Item No.2: Proposal for export of 150 MT onion seeds c.v. N-53 to Gujranwala, Pakistan by M/s. Bharat Agro Overseas (India), A -64, Industrial Area, G.T. Karnal Road, Delhi-110033.**

The Committee recommended the above three proposals for export of Onion seeds (*Allium cepa L*) as stated above. The Committee recalled that National Biodiversity Authority has informed vide their letter No. 8/2/213/2003-NBA(S)/606 dated 11th February, 2009 stated **“that the NBA has prepared a Draft Notification to implement Sec. 40 of the Biodiversity Act. This draft notification is prepared only to declare the items which are normally traded commodities. Onion (*Allium cepa*) is also listed in the draft notification prepared by NBA on normally traded commodities. This is also listed for export under DGFT with HS-Code. Hence, you may take decision on this matter as appropriate.”**

EXPORT OF SUNHEMP SEED

- Item No.5: Proposal for export of 20 M.T. Sunhemp Seed c.v. Local BLR to Japan by M/s. Tokita Seed India (P) Limited, No. 360, 13th Main, 80 Feet Road, A Sector, Yelahanka New Town, Bangalore – 560 065.**

Taking into consideration the views of ICAR representative in the meeting, the availability and requirement of green manure seeds of the country and the fact that the material in question is local germplasm, the Committee did not recommend the export of 20 M.T. Sunhemp Seed c.v. Local BLR to Japan by M/s. Tokita Seed India (P) Limited, No. 360, 13th Main, 80 Feet Road, A Sector, Yelahanka New Town, Bangalore – 560 065.

IMPORT OF BARLEY

- Item No.6: Proposal for import of 3 Kgs. Barley (*Hordeum vulgare*) and 3 Kgs. Linseed (*Linum usitatissimum*) for ISTA lab. sample purpose from Switzerland by M/s. Mahyco Seeds Limited, 4E/15, Ashoka Centre, IIIrd Floor, Jhandewalan Extension New Delhi-55.**

The Committee noted that as per information provided, the firm has been accredited by ISTA on 14th July, 2005 for three years. As such the validity of accreditation has expired as on date. Therefore, the Committee did not recommended import of 3 Kgs. Barley (*Hordeum vulgare*) and 3 Kgs. Linseed (*Linum usitatissimum*) for trial purpose of ISTA from Switzerland by M/s. Mahyco Seeds Limited, 4E/15, Ashoka Centre, IIIrd Floor, Jhandewalan Extension New Delhi-55.

IMPORT OF HYBRID RICE SEEDS

Item No.7: Proposal for import of total 46 kgs. Hybrid Rice Seeds C.V. LP-0882 and LP-0883 @ 23 kgs each from China by M/s. J. K. Agri Genetics Limited, 1-10-177, 4th Floor, Varun Towers, Begumpet, Hyderabad-500 016 (AP) .

The Committee noted that as per para 4.2 of the New Policy on Seed Development, 1988 no immediate imports of Wheat and Paddy seed are considered necessary. It also noted that the Policy also provides that DAC and DARE will keep in close touch with FAO and CGAIR in regard to the latest development abroad in Wheat and Paddy. Further, the policy provides that it is necessary to increase the production of both cereals – oilseeds and pulses by making available high-yielding varieties to the farmers. Therefore, the Committee recommended to obtain a report from ICAR/NBPGR along with quantity to be permitted for import for initial trials in accordance with the Policy.

The Committee deferred the proposal to import 2,00,000 Nos. Olive plants C.V. Rajasthan Olive Cultivation Limited, Pant Krishi Bhawan, Jaipur-302 005 for want of Pest Risk Analysis Report(PRA) and Post Entry Quarantine(PEQ) Certificate, which are prerequisite.

Rajasthan Olive Cultivation Limited, Pant Krishi Bhawan, Jaipur-302 005, for want of Post Entry Quarantine(PEQ) Certificate, which is prerequisite.

EXTENSION OF VALIDTY PERIOD OF OIL PALM

Item No.36: Proposal for import of 2,50,000 Nos. Oil palm germinated sprouts c.v. Tenra Hybrid from CIRAD France by M/s. Palm Tech India Limited, # 5-1-61, Ist Floor, Main Road, Suryarao peta, Kakinada – 533 001, East Godavari District, A.P.

The Committee noted that the 129th EXIM Committee recommended to import 6,00,000 Nos. of Oil Palm sprouts from Costa Rica/Malasia on 25th August, 2008 by M/s. Palm Tech India Limited, # 5-1-61, 1st Floor, Main Road, Suryarao peta, Kakinada – 533 001, East Godavari District, A.P. Out of the total quantity the firm made arrangement to import 3,50,000 Nos of Oil Palm sprouts and the balance of 2,50,000 Nos. of oil palm sprouts are yet to be imported. Therefore, the company requested the EXIM Committee to extend the validity period for the balance quantity and change of source for import.

Accordingly, the Committee recommended to import the balance quantity of 2,50,000 Nos. of Oil sprouts from CIRAD France instead of Costa Rica/Malasia upto 24th July, 2009, subject to the Plant Quarantine (Regulation of import into India) Order, 2003, and amendment made therein.

IMPORT OF ASIAN PEAR PLANTS

Item No.37: Proposal for import of total 860 plants of Asian Pear c.v. Housi-455 Nos., Shinseiki-195 Nos., Raja-96 Nos. and Large Korean-114 Nos. from USA by M/s. Wayside Gardens & Nurseries Pvt. Ltd., 6th Mile Tadong, Gangtok-737102 (Sikkim).

The Committee recommended to import 860 plants of Asian Pear c.v. Housi-455 Nos., Shinseiki-195 Nos., Raja-96 Nos. and Large Korean-114 Nos. from USA by M/s. Wayside Gardens & Nurseries Pvt. Ltd., 6th Mile Tadong, Gangtok-737102 (Sikkim), subject to the Plant Quarantine (Regulation of import into India) Order, 2003, and amendment made therein.

The Committee directed the Division as below:

- i. To amend the application form to be filed by companies for export/import to incorporate important information not presently included particularly the ITC(HS) Classification of Export and Import items, 2007-08. The proforma will be put up separately for the approval of the Chairman of the Committee on file and also be uploaded on the website for the use of the public.**
- ii. The cases where the basic pre-requisites/information have not been provided by the Company such as seed dealer licence, ITC (HS) Classification, etc., should not be put up for consideration of the Committee. Applicants may be informed about deficiencies.**
- iii. The essential information/documents required to be furnished by a party for its case to be taken up for consideration should be indicated while putting up the application for consideration of the Committee.**

The Committee noted that despite pointing out repeatedly, the Section was not filling the proforma for consideration of application properly. This was viewed seriously. It would be the personal responsibility of the in-charge of the Section to provide correct and full information on the proforma to the Committee.

The Committee noted that the Section was not furnishing the list of pending cases. In view of above direction, it decided that the Section must furnish information of following in the next meeting:

- i. Cases pending with the Section.**
- ii. Cases not put up to the Committee and returned to the parties for non-compliance of essential requirements.**

Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
