

Minutes of the 139th EXIM Committee meeting for Export and Import of Seeds and Planting Materials held on 2nd September, 2009 at 3.00 p.m. under the Chairmanship of Shri G.C.Pati, Additional Secretary, Government of India.

The 139th EXIM Committee meeting for Export and Import of Seeds and Planting Materials was held on 2nd September, 2009 at 3.00 p.m. under the Chairmanship of Shri G.C.Pati, Additional Secretary, Government of India and the meeting was attended by officers from Seeds Divisions, Horticulture Division, PP Division of DAC, ICAR and other organizations. Item No.1: Action Taken Report of 138th EXIM Committee meeting held on 4th August, 2009.

The Committee noted that the recommendation letters and proceedings of the 138th EXIM Committee meeting were issued to all the concerned on 10th August, 2009 and the same have also been uploaded on the website of the Government of India for the use of public.

Item No.1(a) Proposal for import of 30 M.T. Babycorn seed c.v. NP 5040 & NP 5004 – 15 M.T. each from Thailand by M/s. Syngenta India Limited, Seed Division, 1170/27, Revenue Colony, Shivaji Nagar, Pune – 411005.

The Committee decided in its 138th EXIM Committee meeting to treat Babycorn as vegetable(as in case of Sweet Corn) as the Scheme of Technology Mission of Integrated Development of Horticulture of DAC provides financial assistance under the scheme for cultivation of Babycorn as vegetable and this decision has been disseminated to all concerned and through website for public use.

Taking into consideration of the above, the Company in question approached the EXIM Committee with the request that the Babycorn is to be considered as vegetable and recommend for import.

Keeping in view of the above, the Committee recommended to import total 30 M.T. Babycorn seed c.v. NP 5040 & NP 5004 – 15 M.T. each from Thailand by M/s. Syngenta India Limited, Seed Division, 1170/27, Revenue Colony, Shivaji Nagar, Pune – 411005, subject to the Plant Quarantine (Regulation of import into India) Order, 2003 and amendment made therein.

Item No.1(b) Proposal for import of 30 M.T. Babycorn seed c.v. SG 17 from Thailand by M/s. Syngenta India Limited, Seed Division, 1170/27, Revenue Colony, Shivaji Nagar, Pune – 411 005.

The Committee decided in its 138th EXIM Committee meeting to treat Babycorn as vegetable(as in case of Sweet Corn) as the Scheme of Technology Mission of Integrated Development of Horticulture of DAC provides financial assistance under the scheme for cultivation of Babycorn as vegetable and this decision has been disseminated to all concerned and through website for public use.

Taking into consideration of the above, the Company in question approached the EXIM Committee with the request that the Babycorn is to be considered as vegetable and recommend for import.

Keeping in view of the above, the Committee recommended to import 30 M.T. Babycorn seed c.v. SG 17 from Thailand by M/s. Sygenta India Limited, Seed Division, 1170/27, Revenue Colony, Shivaji Nagar, Pune – 411 005, subject to the Plant Quarantine (Regulation of import into India) Order, 2003 and amendment made therein.

Item No.1(c): Amendment in the Application Format for Export and Import of Seeds & Planting Materials

The 135th EXIM Committee directed the QC Wing of Seed Division that the Application Format for the Export and Import of Seeds & Planting Materials are to be amended so as to meet the requirement of the EXIM Committee.

Accordingly, application format has been revised and circulated to all concerned for their comments. The members have accepted the amended form and approved for circulation except for suggestion of NBPGR for requiring a certificate of NBPGR to be enclosed. This may not be necessary in view of the requirement that for import of restricted new variety of seeds, trial has to be conducted through ICAR, which through internal circular can advise concerned ICAR institution to send sample to NBPGR for storing germplasm. The Committee accordingly approved the revised Application format. Seeds Division may initiate action to circulate the format to all concerned with approval of Competent Authority.

Item No.1(ii): Proposal for import of 15 M.T. Sunflower seeds c.v. PAC 3789 from Argentina by M/s. Advanta India Limited, No.203-205, 2nd floor, Bhuvana Towers, Sarojini Devi Road, Secunderabad – 500 003.

M/s. Advanta India Limited submitted an application for import of 15 MT Sunflower seeds c.v. PAC 3789 from Argentina. This proposal was deferred by the 137th EXIM Committee held in the month of June, 2009 for want of confirmation on the data of Sunflower Annual Report, 2008-09 by All India Coordinated Research Project on Sunflower, Dte. of Oil Seed Research, Hyderabad dated 28th March, 2009, in which the cultivar in question has been subjected in multi-locational trials. The representative from ICAR has confirmed the data and further stated that "PAC-3789, the sunflower hybrid proposed by M/s. Advanta India limited has been evaluated at multi-locations viz. Ludhiana and Faridkot of Punjab in 2008. This hybrid has also been evaluated in initial hybrid trial Set-II, Kharif 2008-09 under AICRP on Sunflower Project. In the multi-location trials conducted in Punjab, PAC-3789 with seed yield of 2682 kg/ha and oil yield of 1209 kg/ha, performed better than the best check PSH-569. In AICRP trial, PAC-3789 with seed yield of 1449 kg/ha and oil yield of 556 kg/ha performed marginally better than only one check KBSH-1 out of 3 checks studied. The data enclosed along with the proposal by M/s. Advanta India Limited is also confirmed".

Taking into consideration of the above, the Committee recommended to import of 15 M.T. Sunflower seeds c.v. PAC 3789 from Argentina by M/s.
